MCR Wrangler Duties

Pull designated horses that are assigned for trail riding that day.

Halter and bring up to the hitching posts.

Groom; including mane, tail, and hoof.

Saddle and bridle.

Assist customers with paperwork, helmets, and horse assignment.

Assist with customer mount up.

Assist on trail rides.

Help feed and untack.

Return horses to their paddocks.

Wrangler Requirements

You must be between the ages of 16 and 70.

You must have a basic knowledge of horsemanship.

You must be comfortable in the saddle.

You must be able to volunteer twice per month. Check the calendar for riding times.

You must be friendly and outgoing. You will be assisting with our customers, and our customers are here to have a GREAT time!

You must have a love of horses!

And finally, while you do need to be comfortable in the saddle, you don't have to be a GREAT rider. We'll MAKE you a great rider.

This opportunity is perfect for anyone who is looking to purchase a horse in the future and needs to learn care and upkeep. This is also ideal for the adult who wants to ride a horse on a regular basis and keep up their skills, but really can't afford it.
